



12pm-6pm Allotted times for booths to set up between these hours...email will be sent by 9/27 to vendors with time they should arrive to set up.

7pm – 10pm Booths open for business

7pm - Street Dance begins. Tommy Joe Wilson will be performing...you can find some of his songs on iTunes.

Oct. 4th

Booths will be open 8am-3pm

Parade begins at 10am. Starts at North Elementary and travels to park. No driving thru, parking or dropping kids off at North Elementary or on Billie Martin Pkwy. Only complete floats come down Billie Martin Pkwy and line up in the pick-up lines at North Elementary. Tex Hatley drive will be closed to thru traffic. Use the high school parking lot to gather your float riders etc. Also, parents can pick up kids from the floats back at High school parking lot. Floats will not be allowed to unload or stop at the park...you have to continue North on 450 and take Cal Young Rd. back to high school....this is for the safety of everyone involved! **FLOATS, PERFORMERS, VEHICLES are NOT ALLOWED TO STOP AND PERFORM DURING THE MIDDLE OF THE PARADE!** Motorcycles, 4 wheelers, jeeps can NOT do any "showing off" that could endanger the spectators – you will be removed from the parade if you do. We want this to be a safe and fun family experience.




Message From our Police Department


