**V. Consent Agenda**

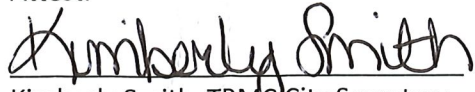

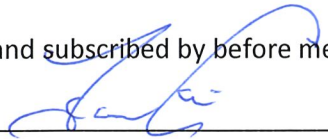
