I. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Mayor Jesse Casey.

II. Invocation

IV. Consent Agenda – April 2021

Mayor Jesse Casey asked to approve the Consent Agenda Items including City Administrator's Report, Police Department Summary for April 2021, the Water Department Summary for April 2021, the Permit Report for April 2021, and the Monthly Financials for April 2021.

City Administrator Marty Byers briefly discussed several items listed on the City Administrator’s Report.

Motion was made by Mayor Pro Tem Gary Lovelace, seconded by Alderman Brant Cain, to approve the April 2021 Consent Agenda as presented. The motion carried unanimously

V. Items to Be Considered

1. Consider and act upon accepting Petition for Annexation and zoning of 73.21 acres of land in the Richard Hooper Survey, A-304 as requested by Faron Cain.

Motion was made by Alderman Charlie Hunt, seconded by Alderwoman Lauren Bresch, to accept the Petition for Annexation of 73.21 acres located on Waldron Ferry Road submitted by Mr. Faron Cain and the Zoning Classification of Single Family Residential (SF-8). Further, that the Petition be referred to the Planning and Zoning Commission for their review, public hearings and recommendation back to this Council. The motion carried unanimously.

2. Consider and act upon amending line items in the 2020-2021 Adopted Budget, transferring \$2,300 from Police Department Legal, Engineering and Accounting to Police Department Payroll Expense.

Motion was made by Alderman Charlie Hunt, seconded by Alderman Brant Cain, to authorize the transfer of \$2,300 from Police Department “Legal, Engineering & Accounting” line item to Police Department – “Payroll Expenses” line item. The \$2,300 will be applied to the Police Chief’s salary for performing the responsibilities of Code Enforcement. The motion carried unanimously.
