Call to Order I.

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 P.M. by Mayor Jesse Casey.

VI. Consent Agenda – September 2025

Mayor Jesse Casey asked to approve the Consent Agenda Items including City Administrator's Report for October 2025, Police Department Summary/Fire Marshal Report for October 2025, Water Department Summary for October 2025, Permit Report for October 2025, Monthly Financials for October 2025, and the Minutes of the October 21, 2025 Regular Meeting.

After a discussion regarding several items on the City Administrator's Monthly Report, a motion was made by Alderman Charlie Hunt, seconded by Alderwoman Lara Hood, to approve the 2025 Consent Agenda Items as presented. The motion carried unanimously.

VII. Items to be Considered

1. Consider and approve a variance from the adopted 10 foot set back to a 2 foot set back on the rear property line of 515 Laurel Lane for the homeowner to build a guest house for his grandparent.

Motion was made by Alderman Charlie Hunt, seconded by Alderman Brant Cain, to grant a variance from the adopted 10 foot set back to a 2 foot set back on the eastern property line of 515 Laurel Lane for the homeowner to build a guest house. The motion carried unanimously.

2. Consider and possibly act to deny SWEPCO's request to increase rates dated October 13, 2025, and adopting Resolution No. 2025-09 denying SWEPCO's proposed rates.

Motion was made by Mayor Pro-Tem Guy Walker, seconded by Alderwoman Lauren Bresch, to deny the rate increase requested by SWEPCO and that Resolution No. 2025-09 be passed to that effect. The motion carried unanimously.

Reassignment, Duties, Discipline, Dismissal, Complaint), and/or Section 551.072, Real Estate Transactions.
