

ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS OR
MISSILE PROJECTORS

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Hallsville,
Texas:

(1)

It shall be unlawful for any person, other than a peace officer in the discharge of his duties, to discharge any gun, pistol, or firearm of any kind, or discharge an air rifle or air pistol of any description by whatever name known, that by means of compressed air, compressed gas, springs, or any other means is capable of discharging shots, pellets, or any solid object at a velocity in excess of 300 feet per second, within the corporate limits of the City.



It shall be unlawful for any person to cause or knowingly permit his child or ward under the age of 18 years to discharge any gun, pistol, or firearm of any kind, or to discharge an air rifle or an air pistol of any description, by whatever name known, that by means of compressed air, compressed gas, springs, or any other means is capable of discharging shots, pellets, or any solid object at a velocity in excess of 300 feet per second, within the corporate limits of the City.

The fact that the City of Hallsville does not now have any regulation nor prohibition of a discharge of firearms or missile projectors which create a hazard to the welfare of the public creates an emergency that this ordinance be passed as an emergency measure on its first reading.
