ORDINANCE NO. 1-76

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON A SECTION OF FARM TO MARKET ROAD 450 (CENTRAL STREET) IN THE CITY OF HALLSVILLE, TEXAS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES INsofar AS THE SAME ARE IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Hallsville, Texas and the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation have conducted engineering studies and traffic investigations to determine the safe limits of parking upon Farm to Market Road 450 (Central Street) within the corporate limits of Hallsville, Texas; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the engineering studies and traffic investigations that a NO PARKING ZONE should be established as set out hereinafter; and

WHEREAS, said NO PARKING ZONE as hereinafter set forth has been recommended by the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation from its own independent investigation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HALLSVILLE, TEXAS:

SECTION 1.

That the following described section of Farm to Market Road 450 (Central Street) be designated as a NO PARKING ZONE and it shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle to park said vehicle within said NO PARKING ZONE being more fully described as follows:

A. ON THE EAST SIDE OF FARM TO MARKET ROAD 450 (CENTRAL ST.)

No parking from the center line of US 80 to 69 feet south and from 153 feet south of US 80 south 79 feet to the center line of the T & P Railway track, a total no parking zone distance of 148 feet.

B. ON THE WEST SIDE OF FARM TO MARKET ROAD 450 (CENTRAL ST.)

No parking from the center line of US 80 south to 82 feet south and from 102 feet south of US 80 south 130 feet to the center line of the T & P Railway track, a total no parking zone distance of 212 feet.

SECTION 2.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.

SECTION 3.

That the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation is authorized to erect signs indicating NO PARKING ZONE as hereinabove designated.


SECTION 4.

That any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined in any sum not exceeding Five Dollars (\$ 5.00).

SECTION 5.

If any portion of this ordinance shall be judicially determined to be invalid, such invalidity shall affect only that portion thereby so found and shall not be construed so as to affect or otherwise impair the validity of the remaining portions therein.
